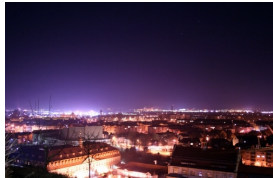


CCCE-Internship "culture and architecture"

- **Bamberg,**

once an Imperial city, lies in the north of Bavaria and is listed as UNESCO World Cultural Heritage. Bamberg is one of the few cities in Germany that was not destroyed by World War II bombings because of a nearby Artillery Factory that prevented planes from getting near to Bamberg.

- **Regensburg**

is famous for the medieval architecture of its well-preserved historic city centre, complete with narrow streets and romantic squares. The atmosphere is decidedly Mediterranean, which causes some people to call it 'the most northern town in Italy'. Major sights include Regensburg's cathedral ('Dom St. Peter') featuring an impressive museum of precious liturgical instruments and devices, Porta Praetoria, a Roman city gate, chapel St. Jakob, which is decorated in Rococo style.



- **Schloss Neuschwanstein**

Seven weeks after the death of King Ludwig II in 1886, Neuschwanstein was opened to the public. The shy king had built the castle in order to withdraw from public life - now vast numbers of people came to view his private refuge. Today Neuschwanstein is one of the most popular of all the palaces and castles in Europe.

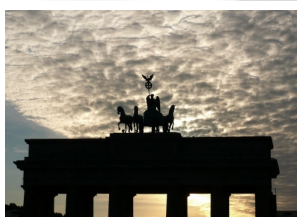
- **Munich**

Munich, one of Germany's most popular travel destinations, has much to offer. Boasting museums and a vibrant art scene, the city centre is easily accessible on foot and extremely attractive. The charming old town embraces many fine examples of Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque and neo-classical architecture. At its centre lies an open expanse of cafes and bars called the 'Marienplatz'. The 'Glockenspiel' chimes away at noon and draws masses to the city hall.



- **Rhine Valley**

Due to its stunning beauty, the *Rhine* is an immensely popular holiday destination. Castles, cathedrals, woods and vineyards, hiking trails and a romantic river bed all contribute to the scenery, which inspired numerous poets and painters. Clemens Brentano, Friedrich Hölderlin, Heinrich Heine, August and Friedrich Schlegel all composed parts of their main works in the vicinity of the Rhine.

- **Berlin**
